ABOUT THE SEMINAR

Artificial Intelligence (AI) is transforming knowledge systems, governance, education, agriculture, healthcare and environmental management. It is rapidly changing the way we live, learn, work and solve social and developmental challenges. At the same time, North East India has a rich heritage of indigenous knowledge related to agriculture, biodiversity, environment, health practices, languages and cultural traditions.

The two-day national seminar on “**Artificial Intelligence, Indigenous Knowledge, and Sustainable Development in North East India**” aims to bring together academicians, researchers, scholars, students, policymakers and indigenous knowledge holders to discuss these important issues.

The seminar will explore how AI can be used for the preservation of indigenous knowledge, protection of biodiversity, sustainable agriculture, climate resilience, education and inclusive development. It will also discuss important issues relating to ethics, data sovereignty, community rights and cultural heritage.

The seminar seeks to promote research, knowledge sharing and collaboration for achieving sustainable and inclusive development in North East India.
